

The Parish Council defines a grant as a payment made to an organisation for a specific purpose that benefits the Parish or its residents, and which is not directly managed or administered by the Council.

The Council recently received an application from the Anja Wilson Memorial Fund to support cardiac screening for young people aged 14–35. Many residents will have seen online that Anja's family have been raising vital funds in her memory, following her tragic passing due to an undiagnosed heart condition.

At the Parish Council meeting held on Thursday 19th March, members voted unanimously to award the full requested amount of £4,550. This funding will enable cardiac screening for 65 young people living in Clayton.
